- ❖ Two Command strips to hang your finished product without damaging your walls

We recommend that you use your kit within 30 days of purchase to ensure your paint is at its peak quality.

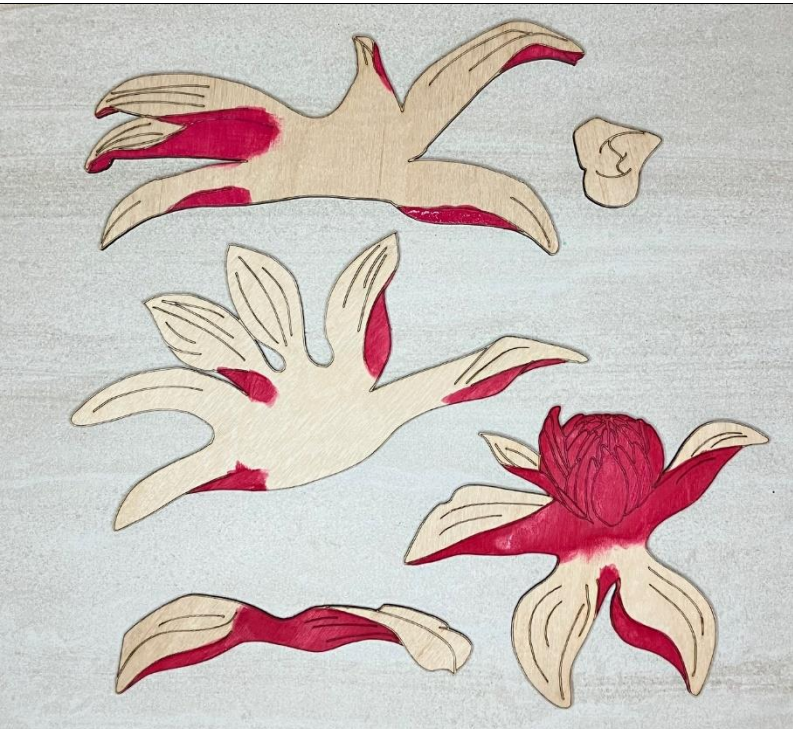

# CHRYSANTHEMUM STEP-BY-STEP



Begin your project by painting a base coat of Fuchsia (3) to the outside portion of the petals.



Next, paint the inside of the flower petals Light Pink (5)



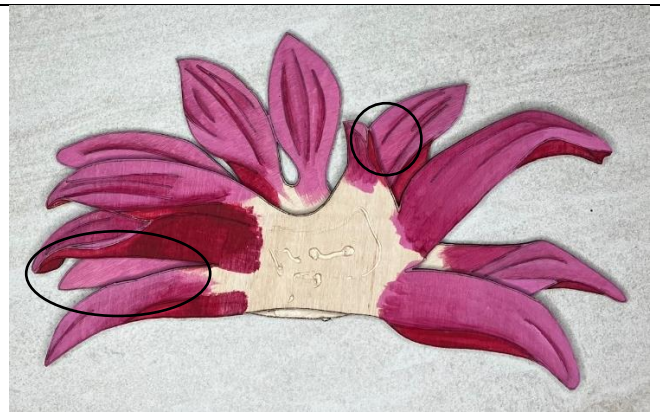
Now we will add depth to the inside of the flower petals with the Shadow Pink (4). You will do this by painting along the engraved lines and towards the bottom inside of the flower.



Highlight the areas that aren't shaded with the Highlight Pink (6). This is a subtle difference, but brightens the flower up real nice. It also helps blend the shading in the previous step.



Now we will assemble the flower using the glue provided, while simultaneously adding the Shadow Pink (4) to the shaded part of the petals.



After you glue each layer, add shading. Reference circles to ensure you line up your project properly.



Don't worry about the wood showing through in some areas. We will add more shading to cover these after assembly.



You can see I added the shadow pink on the center of the flower. It is okay to cover the lines. We will work on this area next.



Last piece!



Now we will add Light Pink (5) to the tips of the center flower.



Work your way around the flower adding shadow detailing with black. You will want a lot of water on your paint brush and a small amount of black. I added arrows to point out some of the shaded areas.



Now add small white highlights to various petals.
