- ✤ Glue to complete your masterpiece
- Two Command strips to hang your finished product without damaging your walls

30 LAYERED WOOD

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IDAHO WILDFLOWER STEP-BY-STEP

Begin your project by painting a base coat of White (1) on the bee and flowers of this piece.	Next, paint the petals of the Syringa flowers White (1), then add Fuchsia (4) to the leaf tips & bottom right flowers.
Add Lime Green (6) to the center of the Suringe	Leaving a slender line of Euchria on the odder of
Add Lime Green (6) to the center of the Syringa leaves, stems and buds as shown above.	Leaving a slender line of Fuchsia on the edges of the leaves, blend the Dark Green (7) into the Lime Green in the center of the leaves. Then fill in the rest of the stems.

Add Olive Green (8) to the stems of the bottom right flowers.	Blend the Purple (3) paint into the Fuchsia flower petals of the bottom right flowers.
Paint the center of the Euchsia flowers with	Finally add Sky Blue (9) to shade the Syringa flower
Paint the center of the Fuchsia flowers with Mustard Yellow (5). You may choose to also add it	Finally add Sky Blue (9) to shade the Syringa flower petals. Use a small amount of blue and mostly
to the center of the White Syringa flowers.	water to keep it light and easier to blend.

Paint your bee's face and body with Mustard Yellow (5), then add a small amount of yellow to the top portion of the flowers at random.
Finally add Black (2) to your bee and create its
unique path from the flowers below. Some clients have added a heart to their bee path!
