 - Please note that I make a lot of these colors, so they may need to be premixed
- Printed step-by-step directions with photo reference (attached to this paper)
- ✤ Glue to complete your masterpiece
- Two Command strips to hang your finished product without damaging your walls


<u>Squaw butte step-by-step</u>



Step One: Sky Start with Yellow (4) in the right corner, then Red (3), and end with a small amount of Purple (8) in the left corner



Step Three: Second Mountain Paint a base layer of Navy Blue (6)



Step Five: Water Paint a base layer of Midnight Blue (7)



Step Two: First Mountain Paint a base layer of Sky Blue (5)



Step Four: Third Mountain Paint a base layer of Purple (8)



Base Layers Complete!

First Mountain Layer	Second Mountain Layer
Use Mightnight Blue (7) to shade this mountain	Used Black (2) to shade this mountain
Third Mountain Layer	Water Layer
Use Black (2) to shade this mountain layer	Add Navy Blue to the "waterfall" portion of the water and the beach
Add Sky Blue (5) to the beach edge and paint	Add Light Brown (9) in dabbing motions, then add
streaks down the "fall" portion of the waterfall	Dark Brown (10) on the bottom side of rocks

Add a little more Sky Blue (5) to the "fall part of the waterfall, and on the lower half of the river	Add the White Water with White (1) by dabbing and then adding light streaks under the mist
Wild Grass baseline using Black (2) Note: take a pencil and line the top of the water layer to find the grass line	Add mist layer with Sky Blue (5)
Now we will be working with Black only (2). Add Evergreens	Then add trees and branches
